

CROSS COUNTRY.



An article appeared in the Hebden Bridge Times on Friday 23rd September relating to Kay and myself and the FRA Relay Championship. Anyone familiar with the sport will realise it contains some minor inaccuracies. However, the point that concerns Kay and myself is that, despite our emphasising to the reporter on a number of occasions that this event was being organised jointly by Todmorden Harriers and Calder Valley Fell Runners, and that we were just the co-ordinators, the article did not mention the clubs concerned. We therefore felt it appropriate to write this letter to the two clubs to re-iterate that we see our role as co-ordinating the excellent organisation and hard work that has, and is still being, carried out by the two clubs concerned. We are the first to recognise that this is a team effort between Todmorden Harriers and Calder Valley Fell Runners and that in speaking to the reporter concerned we said nothing to detract from this. We were therefore disturbed to read an article which could be seen by those reading it that the relay was a "Bernard and Kay" event.

If you have a message or important news item which needs to be circulated to other Calder Valley members, then we have come up with a quick and, (we hope) efficient system to help you. It takes the form of a 'phone chain system, whereby each Club member recieves one call, and then relays the message to 2 other members. Each of those two members then call 2 members each and soon the message gets to everyone.

This system needs YOU to make it a success; HERE'S HOW IT WORKS :-

You need marshalls for your race, You need to spread the word about a social quiz night or the date of a fellerace fixture has been changed.

Duncan will then start the chain by 'phoning his 2 designated contacts who will in turn do the same, and so on. You could also, of course, jump the queue a little by also 'phoning your contacts after you have given Duncan your message, so speeding up the process considerably.
